

ALPE-ADRIA-CLASSIC-CHALLENGE 2018

... in April the new season will start in Italy with new ideas

In 2017 almost 30 teams participated in the Alpe-Adria-Classic-Challenge – AACC for short. Pilots from four nations accepted the challenge of the six events in four different countries.

At the end of the season, Luigi SPECOGNA, Italy, was able to gain the overall victory of the AACC with his Autobianchi A 112 Abarth, built in 1980, with a score of 165.2 points. He was followed by Sergio OLIVA, Italy, with a score of 129,8 points and Michael BERGER, Austria, with 127,2 points.

The organizers of the Alpe-Adria-Classic-Challenge have provided some innovations in 2018: For further improvement of the quality of the AACC events, a rating formula has been developed by our friends from Slovenia; different criteria of an event have been considered in this calculation:

The AACC factors should serve as an aid for selecting the events you want to participate

For example the length of the route, number of special stages, road book, time necessary for evaluation of results, hospitality, quality of food, entry fee, organization a.s.o. are taken into account.

For sure this will be an approach to increase the ambitions of the organizers to improve the quality of their event once more. Finally, any improvement of the above mentioned evaluation criteria re-
